For those of you who regularly feel the pain of other human beings who are starving, needing clean water, being subjected to human trafficking, civil wars, unsafe homes, facing natural disasters, needing a surgery etc., and wish you could do more for them, this Pink Sheet Expander has been created for you.

- ❑ **1. Water** / Pray for Basha and women like her in Garaftole Villiage in Ethiopia, where water scarcity causes women to stand in line twice a day for 3 hours to collect water in an often contaminated stream. Basha hopes to have clean water saying, "then, we would be able to turn our attention towards improving our economy and raising our children safely." Pray that Lifewater's project in this village would be fully funded, soon providing clean water and sanitation training to this community improving health and economic circumstances. - ❑ **2. Wars** / Pray for Ali, a 10-year-old Syrian refugee displaced by the 10-year civil war, who works and cannot attend school. Violence has caused 5.6 million to cross borders and 6.2 million to be displaced within Syria and killed hundreds of thousands. Nearly 12 million people in Syria need humanitarian assistance. Ask God to protect those who have left everything behind in search of safety. Pray that God will move the nations of the world to seek compassionate solutions for Syria's refugees and displaced families. Pray for God to open your eyes to ways you can respond. Ask God to continue to provide for World Vision and other relief agencies who are sharing the gospel and tangible provisions for displaced Syrians. (Source: worldvision.org)
- ❑ **3. Trafficking** / Pray for Christian humanitarian relief agencies, such as Salvation Army, Samaritan's Purse, Faith Alliance Against Slavery and Trafficking, and World Vision to be led by God and granted God's wisdom and provisions as they serve those vulnerable to trafficking. Pray that they would be able to identify and rescue victims of trafficking. (Source: worldvision.org, salvationarmy.org, samaritanspurse.org, and faastinternational.org)
- ❑ **4. Refugees** / Pray for refugees (mostly Rohingya ethnic groups) in Bangladesh fleeing violence in Myanmar as well as the host communities. Ask God to help them during seasonal monsoon rains, threat of cyclones and flooding. Pray that COVID-19 does not spread—increasing the suffering of those in overcrowded, unhygienic camps. Pray that God will grant His peace to those who have experienced war. Pray for a peaceful resolution to the turmoil in Myanmar. Ask God to stir the hearts of Christians around the world to pursue peace and justice for all those affected by injustice. Pray that God will open your eyes to the suffering and show you where you can help. (Source: worldvision.org)
- ❑ **5. Orphans** / Pray for protection of orphans in Cambodia where many running the orphanages are looking only for financial increase and not for the benefit of the child. Pray for the Kinship Projects in Cambodia where they run orphanages that provide 24/7 orphan care, foster care, emergency feeding station, evangelism and discipleship, and community development. Pray for family reunification, when appropriate, and for the physical, spiritual, and emotional needs of children. Pray for wisdom for the workers. Pray that they continue to successfully integrate the communities and families in the care of children. Pray that they continue to thrive and that their staff loves and cares for orphans with the love of God. Pray that the staff would be energized and guided by God. Pray that they experience fruit as they disciple children to be productive Christ followers. (Source: kinshipunited.org)
- ❑ **6. Hunger** / Pray for provision for the people of Pakistan and East Africa where swarms of locusts are destroying crops (which in one day can consume the food of 35,000 people). Ask God to prevent the current eggs from hatching that are expected at harvest time. Pray that needed pesticides are able to get to these areas and that acute hunger does not result in these regions. - ❑ **7. Health** / Pray for the people of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), where several more cases of Ebola were found, just as the World Health Organization was about to declare and end to the epidemic that began in 2018, infecting over 3,000 and killing over 2,000. Pray for provision and wisdom for humanitarian aid groups who warn that DRC could face a "triple emergency": lingering Ebola, a surge in coronavirus cases, and ongoing violence in the war-racked country. Pray for wisdom for officials as they juggle many health concerns having already diverted slim healthcare resources from Ebola to combating COVID-19. - ❑ **8. Water** / Pray for 8-year-old, Ireen, in Malawi, who must walk about 6 kilometers daily to collect dirty water. She misses many days of school because the water makes her ill. Pray for clean water to be available to Ireen and her community soon. (Source: worldvision.org)
- ❑ **9. Wars** / Pray for and end to the conflict in South Sudan that has caused 2.3 million refugees and more than 4 million people to be displaced. Pray that World Vision and other agencies would have the provisions to continue to help with emergency food, livelihood training, healthcare, access to clean water, sanitation and hygiene, and educational opportunities. Pray that children affected by conflict might be able to return to their homes in peace and safety. Pray that worried parents would find joy in knowing that God is with them. Ask God to help kids who are struggling to keep up with their education under difficult circumstances. (Source: worldvision.org)
- ❑ **10. Trafficking** / Continue to pray for the rescue of children who are victims of sexual trafficking. Pray that they hear the gospel and have loving people to encourage them. Ask God to provide food, medical treatment, employment, shelter, and education. (Source: salvationarmy.org)
- ❑ **11. Refugees** / Continue to pray for the millions of Venezuelans who were displaced seeking food, work, and a better life. Pray that World Vision and other agencies would have the provisions to continue to share God's love and meet needs in nearby countries. (Source: worldvision.org)
- ❑ **12. Orphans** / Pray for orphans impacted by the COVID-19 Pandemic. Pray for orphanages like Lifesong for Orphans who are implementing policies for hygiene, visitors, sickness, communications, etc. and are experiencing COVID-related pressures in their ministries in 13 nations. Pray for nutrition needs of orphan worldwide—with schools closed, many orphans are missing meals. Pray for Lifesong's residences in Zambia where the students who were away at college are returning filling residences. Pray for the many ill children in Bolivia and Guatemala would have their immune systems strengthened and for the safety of orphanage staff and children. Ask God to give wisdom and that Christian orphan agencies are prepared for the new influx of orphans cause by the pandemic. (Source: lifesong.org)

- ❑ **13. Hunger** / Pray for consistent food for children like Kham who go to school hungry and cannot concentrate on their studies. Ask God to give wisdom and provision to humanitarian relief agencies (World Vision, Salvation Army, World Relief, Samaritans' Purse, etc.) to meet the needs of the hungry and to share God's love. - ❑ **14. Health** / Pray that children would be able to receive the life-saving malaria treatment Samaritans Purse provided for Abigael Aroleko's 8-month old twins living in DRC. Pray that malaria that kills nearly 800,000 people annually (90% are children) can be eradicated. Ask God to provide one of the best forms of prevention—a \$10 bed net treated with a natural insecticide. Pray for Christian humanitarian aid agencies, like Samaritan's Purse to have the wisdom, love, guidance and provisions needed to continue to train and equip church workers to help their communities combat the spread of malaria as they spread the gospel. - ❑ **15. Water** / Pray for Alma Talipsan and teachers like her in the Philippines who use their own money to buy bottled water for students. (Source: [samaritanspurse.org](http://samaritanspurse.org))
- ❑ **16. Wars** / Pray for the end of armed conflict in Somalia that has caused 870,000 refugees to flee to nearby countries for safety from violence. Some have lived in massive refugee camps for years. Within Somalia, over 2 million people are displaced. Pray that families who have lived away from their homes for a long time would be welcomed into their new societies. Pray for God's miraculous peace to change the situation in Somalia so people can return home in safety. Ask that children would get the nourishment they need to grow up healthy. Ask for God's love to fill you so that you can extend His welcome to those in need around you. (Source: [worldvision.org](http://worldvision.org))
- ❑ **17. Trafficking** / Pray that the eradication of slavery and sex trafficking would be a priority for world leaders. Pray that they would confront sexual trafficking and commercial sexual exploitation by dedicating their time and energy to the issue. Pray they would also commit their national resources toward ending trafficking. (Source: [salvationarmy.org](http://salvationarmy.org))
- ❑ **18. Refugees** / Pray for the 2.5 million people from Afghanistan who are living as refugees. Pray for all those affected by violence—people who have lost loved ones, and those who have been injured. Ask God to come to the aid of those who are personally suffering as a result of the conflict in Afghanistan. Pray that God will move more people to act on their faith. - ❑ **19. Orphans** / Pray for the Atchapuvalasa Kinship Project in the small, rural village of Veeraghattam, India. Pray that they are fruitful as they take care of orphaned children and tell the community about the love of Christ. Ask God to keep the children safe and to energize and guide the staff in rearing these children. (Source: [kinshipunited.org](http://kinshipunited.org))
- ❑ **20. Hunger** / Pray that food would be provided for the people of Yemen who are suffering severe food insecurity. Pray that violence would cease and the food would be able to enter the nation. Pray for the safety and wisdom of humanitarian relief agencies who are struggling to get food to this nation where 400,000 children under 5 are acutely malnourished and that aid workers would be safe. - ❑ **21. Health** / Pray for the adults and children who are susceptible to one of the top 10 killer diseases in the world—diarrhea. Pray for the children in South Asia and sub-Saharan Africa where most of the deaths occur. Pray for prevention of this disease which kills well over 1 million annually and over 1,300 young children daily and accounts for 8 percent of all deaths of children under 5 worldwide. - ❑ **22. Water** / Pray for safe water and health for children like Rohit in India who must collect water from contaminated sources. Pray that every family would have water sanitation kits available to clean the water they collect. Pray that humanitarian agencies such as Compassion International have the provisions and wisdom to help communities improve their water and share the love of Christ effectively. - ❑ **23. Wars** / Pray for peace in Yemen and for the children and adults caught in the aftermath of the war in Yemen. Ask God to provide the needed aid for about 24 million people (80% of Yemen's population). Pray that God would provide and heal the people from the trauma caused by violence, hunger, and deprivation. - ❑ **24. Trafficking** / Pray for solutions to extreme poverty that make people vulnerable to human trafficking around the world. Pray for justice for the perpetrators who lure the poor with the promise of well-paying jobs in other cities or countries. Ask God to help the impoverished become self-sufficient—a way to prevent trafficking. (Source: [worldvision.org](http://worldvision.org))
- ❑ **25. Refugees** / Pray for peace in the Democratic Republic of the Congo where armed conflict has caused over 800,000 refugees fled to other countries and an estimated 4.5 million people to be displaced within the DRC. Ask God to provide for World Vision and other agencies that provide relief and provisions to this vulnerable and suffering group. (Source: [worldvision.org](http://worldvision.org))
- ❑ **26. Orphans** / Pray that Christians would consider adopting or being foster parents to an orphan—demonstrating God's love to the children. Pray for provisions and encouragement for potential adoptive/foster parents. (Source: [cafo.org](http://cafo.org))
- ❑ **27. Hunger** / Pray that food-supply chains remain unhindered due to COVID-19 regulations. Pray that food, seeds, aid, etc. reaches those in need. Pray for the nearly one billion people who currently go to bed hungry each night and the 135 million who suffer acute food insecurity where lack of food is of a severity that threatens lives and livelihoods. (COVID-19 restrictions are predicted to almost double the number to 265 million people who will suffer acute hunger by December 2020.) (Source: [weforum.org](http://weforum.org))
- ❑ **28. Health** / Pray for children like Vijay and Vinod brothers in India who contracted tuberculosis. Pray that the 1 million children who are infected annually would be diagnosed and survive like Vijay (unlike Vinod who was undiagnosed and died). Pray that there would be drugs developed for the 32,000 who develop a drug-resistant strain each year. Ask God to help doctors diagnose and treat TB, which is difficult to diagnose in children (about 680 dying daily). (Source: [worldvision.org](http://worldvision.org))
